1 Enforcement Policy


The SZC Harbour Authority exercises a range of techniques in educating and where necessary enforcing compliance with regulations that help promote and maintain marine safety. Those techniques range from steps, such as issuing guidance, education, and advice, to ongoing surveillance and accident investigation, and where necessary giving verbal warnings, formal warnings and in serious cases, taking legal action.

The SZC Harbour Authority seeks to act in accordance with the following principles in its approach to marine enforcement:

- Ensure that guidance and advice is available.
- Exercise proportionate methods of enforcement on the basis of the nature and circumstances of the offence.
- Carry out investigations in the event of a marine incident.
- Initiate criminal proceedings when it is considered appropriate.




